Through its successful Cars4Careers program, ASCEF turns donated cars into education and training for individuals wanting a career in the automotive service industry. Each year, ASCEF awards scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$1,000 to high school seniors who plan to enroll in post-high school technical/academic training or college undergraduates in the automotive service field. Since the establishment of the Foundation in 1998, ASCEF has awarded \$183,750 in scholarships.

“These scholarships are a fantastic opportunity to support students in pursuing their educational goals in automotive repair and will help meet the demand for skilled technicians in our industry, which is at an all-time high,” said David Kusa, ASCEF President. “The 2023 scholarship application opens in October and we encourage all those to apply by March 31, 2023.”
